## Citation style guide for the Undergraduate Research Scholars Program 2023-24 AY

This document will cover the basics of each citation style with links to further resources. Your citation style MUST follow one of the below styles. No exceptions are granted. Consult with your faculty advisor to determine which citation style is appropriate for your field.

It is highly recommended that you use reference management software such as Endnote, Mendeley, or Zotero. These tools are not perfect but can considerably cut down on the amount of time spent formatting references.

Pay attention to punctuation, italics, bold, underlines, abbreviations, using "And" or "&" and any other formatting elements. Your references should be complete and not miss any information such as journal volume, page numbers, years, authors, or DOI numbers, where applicable.

Note these examples are not exhaustive as there are variations for multiple authors, same author same year, and for referring to different media. Consult the guides for your specific citation style.
