

 - Seek to understand the laws of other countries.
- STUDENT OWNERSHIP OF WORK

 Find the rules governing ownership of student work at your university.
- WORKS FOR HIRE, JOINT WORKS

 Talk about ownership with your faculty advisor and all others involved EARLY.
- COLLECTIVE WORKS

 Find out the copyright protections or permissions of journals, websites, etc., before publishing.



In-text Citations



- Parenthetical (e.g., APA, MLA)
- Footnote or Endnote (e.g., Chicago notes-bibliography)
- Numeric (e.g., IEEE)

FORMATTING EXAMPLES

- APA: (Author, Year) e.g., (Smith, 2022)
- MLA: (Author Page) e.g., (Smith 23)
- Chicago (notes): Superscript number, followed by full citation in footnote — e.g., .¹
- IEEE: Numbered references in square brackets e.g., [1]

In-text Citations



- Parenthetical (e.g., APA, MLA)

• MLA:

Last, First. "Article Title." Journal Name, vol. #, no. #, year, pp. ##-##. Publisher, source.

Chicago:

First Last, "Article Title," Journal Name #, no. # (Year): #-#, https://doi.org/xxxxx.

• IEEE:

[#] F. M. Last, "Title," Journal Name., vol. #, no. #, pp. #-#, Mo. Yr., doi: xxxxx.

• MLA:

Chicago:

First Last, "Article Title," Journal Name #, no. # (Year): #-#, https://doi.org/xxxxx.

• IEEE:

[#] <mark>F. M. Last,</mark> "Title," Journal Name., vol. #, no. #, pp. #-#, Mo. Yr., doi: xxxxx.
